



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IMPORTANT

Read instructions throughly prior to installation. Installation should be performed by a qualified professional.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Unplug electrical connectors to the headlights, radiator cooling fan and use a T30 torx driver to remove all front-end plastics. Use a T20 torx for the headlight brackets. Place the front plastics with hood and headlights in a safe place where they cannot be damaged.
- 2. Use the supplied M6 nuts, bolts and washers to assemble the upper and lower shock tower brackets. Place a washer on the screw, insert the screw into one of the 4 holes, then add another washer and follow with a nylock nut. Tighten until snug (thread locker is not required).
- 3. Remove the radiator bolts and secure it with something like zip ties or wire while you mock up the bracket. Lift the front end and secure. Remove the bolts holding the OE shock tower brace and shocks.
- 4. Hold the brace up to the front end to see where the hardware will go. Use an 8mm or 21/64" drill bit to open up the holes where hardware will be installed on the lower bracket.
- 5. Use the supplied M8 hardware to install the lower bracket on the frame. Place a washer on the screw, insert the screw into one of the 6 holes, place a washer on the screw and follow with a nylock nut.
- 6. Reinstall hardware for the radiator, reinstall the shocks to the upper mounts and reinstall the front fascia. Don't forget to reconnect the electrical for headlights and radiator fan.



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
